The MTSP Adviser helps patients with:

- Advice regarding a patient's options for legal processes following a serious injury
- Practical information on how to access enhanced rehabilitation through the personal injury process
- Signpost patients to a personal injury lawyer from the MTSP Legal Panel
- Identifying charities and organisations that can provide help after discharge
- Guidance on available support for victims of crime or 'hit and run'

The MTSP Citizens Advice Adviser provides:

- Advice on employment issues, understanding employment rights, sick pay and any other work related issues
- Practical help with accessing state benefits that may now be an option due to injury or ill-health
- Guidance and support with debt and financial issues, how to manage the situation and deal with creditors
- Support with housing or landlords as well as assistance with any applications for local authority housing, disputes, homelessness or mortgage difficulties

Headway Brain Injury Adviser offers support with:

- Helping people to understand and access the resources they need in the early stages of their iniury recovery
- Emotional and practical support for individuals and their families to understand brain injury and how it affects them
- The opportunity to talk to someone who understands the emotional impact of dealing with brain iniury
- Understanding how to adjust to living life after a brain injury. promoting independence and supporting families
