Clinics held at Addenbrooke's Hospital

Weekly:

- Cancer Genetics (for those with a significant family history of cancer)
- Paediatric Genetics (for children and their families)
- Genetics prenatal clinic (for pregnant women and their partners)
- Huntington's Disease Clinics

Fortnightly or monthly:

- Cardiac (for those with a significant history of heart disease)
- Eye Clinic (for those with genetic eye diseases)
- Multi- Disciplinary Specialist Clinics are held for those with Neurofibromatosis Type 2, Hereditary Spastic Paraplegia, von Hippel-Lindau Syndrome, 22q.11 syndrome, Tuberous Sclerosis, Endocrine and Dermatology disorders
- General Genetics Clinics (for those with a wide range of genetic conditions)
- Renal Clinics (for those with a history of inherited kidney disease)
