Consultants hold clinics every week day. You may be seen for a variety of reasons depending on your general health, pregnancy and medical history. Regular clinics include:

- Diabetic clinic - Tuesdays
- Twins clinic - Thursdays
- Anaesthetist clinic - Tuesdays (you may be asked to attend this clinic if you have any spinal problems, raised BMI or any history of problems with anaesthesia)
- Substance misuse clinic - Thursdays

Antenatal clinic midwives will also see you for your first consultant visit, as well as others listed below.

- Booking clinic - Wednesdays and Fridays (to book a pregnancy at the Rosie for patients living out of the Cambridge area)?
- Blood tests
- Anti D injections
- Pre-op appointment prior to elective caesarean section - Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays
- If your BMI is above 40, a midwife will see you after your appointment with the anaesthetist to give advice on tissue viability and avoiding pressure ulcers.

The phlebotomy department is located within Rosie outpatients and is open from 08:30 - 17:30 Monday - Thursday and 08:30 - 16:30 on Fridays. Please make sure you arrive minutes before closure to allow time for samples to be taken. Your community midwife will advise you if you need to have blood tests done here, rather than at your GP surgery.
